

Possible itinerary for the 7-Day WWI Gallipoli and Ancient Troy trip

A trip to the Gallipoli Battlefields, exploring the surroundings and the cemeteries for those lost in WWI, is a powerful and moving experience your students will never forget. Your group will pay tribute to the fallen by visiting memorials and battlegrounds before making their way to Athens, Greece to unravel the charismatic history of this city. A visit to Troy, the place of one of the most enigmatic battlefields of ancient history is of course a must.

Day One...

AM On arrival in Istanbul, a guide will meet the group at the airport and help with the transfer to your hotel.

PM Time permitting, an initial tour of the city will be conducted before an overnight stay.

Day Two...

AM Depart for Canakkale where on the way you will visit the Gallipoli Battlefields (the northern part of the Peninsula) including Anzac Cove, Ariburnu Cemetery, Beach Cemetery and more.

PM Continue to Canakkale after crossing the Dardanelles by ferry. Enjoy the drive to nearby Troy to visit the site of the legendary city.
After exploring the site of Troy, your group will transfer to your accommodation for an overnight stay in Canakakle.

Day Three...

AM Today, cross the Dardanelles to Eceabat (Gallipoli Peninsula) to visit the Battlefields on the southern part of Peninsula (where the battle took place between Turkish and British troops).

PM After lunch visit the cove/bay where the fierce Sea Battle took place on Dardanelles as well as the Turkish War Memorial, French War Memorial's, Morto Bay, Seddul Bahir and more.
Afternoon drive back to Istanbul for an overnight stay.

Day Four...

AM Spend the full day sightseeing - visiting Topkapi Palace Museum, Hagia Sophia and Underground Cistern.

PM Shop the afternoon away at Grand Bazaar, one of the oldest and largest covered markets in the world.

Day Five...

AM After breakfast transfer to the airport for the flight to Athens. Arrive in Athens where you will visit the National Archaeological Museum and the Acropolis.

PM In the evening visit Plaka, the oldest section of Athens full of authentic Greek shops, restaurants and cafes.

Day Six...

AM Today your group will transfer from Athens to Tolon with a stop in Corinth.

PM When you arrive in Tolon you will have time to explore at your leisure.

Day Seven...

AM Depart for a full day of excursions visiting the Tomb of Agamemnon and Epidavros - the ancient Greek city.

PM Arrive at the beautiful port of Nafplio, which was held as an important seaport in the Middle Ages for the royal houses, before spending the night in Tolon.
